

Public Speaking: Engaging Your Audience

A four-session course

Words may read well on the page, but engaging a live audience is a whole different ballgame. Learn how to put your audience at ease, include humor, structure your topic, add memorable moments, evoke emotion, include personal examples, and end with a power-packed conclusion. You may be a new speaker or an introvert, but with these tips, your audience will never know it.

Session 1: How to Structure Your Presentation to Engage Audience

- State a clear goal/benefit upfront.
- How to create a discernable beginning, middle & end.
- How to incorporate emotive words and use humor effectively.
- How to create an outline and memorize so you can teach from bullet reminders.

Session 2: The Mechanics of a Dynamic Presentation

- Appearance, dress, environment, and engagement.
- Know your audience, keep it conversational, and work with your speaking style (not others).
- How to slow down, make eye contact, take pauses, and practice tone and projection.
- How to keep within the allotted time and ensure people can find you online later.

Session 3: Speaking to a Live Audience

- How does your presentation add value to the audience? Tailor speech around the main takeaway.
- Rehearse, practice with distractions, practice body language/movement, and mentally prepare.
- How to find and speak in your own voice.
- People love unwrapping gifts, so learn how and when to kick in a surprise.

Session 4: Speaking Online: Zoom and Facebook Live

- You will be much closer to your audience: how to check your face and set up the background.
- Use proper equipment: how to use lighting, set up and camera angle to benefit the audience.
- How to structure an animated, lively presentation since the camera is static.
- How to create/offer online resources to keep them engaged with you after the session ends.

The course is taught live by Donna through Zoom. Each one-hour session is \$50 for a total course cost of \$200. Each course includes handouts with insider tidbits learned through 20 years of public speaking.
